

WOODBINE CITY COUNCIL
November 18, 2016 Special Meeting Minutes

Mayor Richard Gau called the Special Woodbine City Council meeting into session Friday, November 18, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. in the City conference room. Council Members Merne Hammitt, John Kerger, David P. Moores, Bryan Willis and Peggy Monahan answered roll call. Others in attendance included RC Androy, Amber Nelson, Staci Marshall and Jeff Johnsen

Justin Futrell from TrueNorth gave a presentation on different health insurance packages for the non-union City employees.

There was a discussion on if Jeff Johnsen owner of the property located on Rawlins Ave. should be allowed to hook up to a septic tank. Different sections of the Woodbine Sewer ordinance were reviewed. There was a conflict between council members on how section 8-1-5 in Chapter 1 Sanitary Sewer System was interpreted. It was moved by Willis, seconded by Moores to have Mayor Gau contact the City attorney and get the City attorney's interpretation of section 8-1-5 in Chapter 1 Sanitary Sewer System of the Woodbine's ordinance book. If the Woodbine City attorney interprets section 8-1-5 that since the property located on Rawlins Ave is situated within the City and abutting on a street where there is not a proper public sewer connection, then the property owner should be allowed to hook up to a septic tank. 5 ayes.
