October 2, 2017 Minutes

Mayor Richard Gau called the Woodbine City Council meeting into session Monday, October 2, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the City conference room. Council Members Merne Hammitt, John Kerger, Bryan Willis, Dave Moores and Peggy Monahan answered roll call. Moved by Hammitt, seconded by Willis to approve Winsupply bill. Hammitt, Kerger, Willis and Monahan were ayes, Moores abstained. Motion passed.

City Administrator gave a report to council.

Moved by Willis, seconded by Moores to adjourn at 7:17 p.m. 5 ayes. Motion passed.
