City Clerk Kelley will send the information to the city's attorney and once the draft is received back she will set up a time for another joint meeting.

Moved by Smith, seconded by Cogdill, to adjourn at 6:44 p.m. Vandemark, Smith and Cogdill were ayes. 3 ayes. Motion passed.
